

INSTRUCTIONS TO DESIGNATE CORPORATE DONATIONS WHEN YOU SHOP AT AMAZON OR KROGER

Amazon Smile

Amazon donates a portion of their profit to community nonprofit organizations that are chosen by the customers through their Amazon Smile webpage. Here's how to shop through Amazon Smile.

1. Go to Smile.Amazon.com. This is a replica of the Amazon.com site. (You must use the Smile.Amazon site to have your purchases count toward Montwell Commons.)
2. Log into your Amazon account (or establish an Amazon account).
3. Search for Greenbrier Valley Restoration in the box and select that as your designated non-profit.
4. Make your purchases. (Purchases that are eligible for donations have an Amazon Smile icon next to them).

Note: Amazon Smile requires that you renew your charitable designation each year.

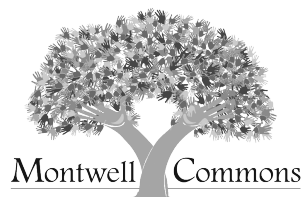
Kroger

Kroger donates a portion of their profit to community nonprofit organizations that are chosen by the customers through their Kroger Plus Card account. Here's how to link your Kroger Card to Montwell Commons.

1. Go to Kroger.com and sign into your online account (or create an online account if you don't have one.)
2. Click on "Edit Kroger Community Rewards" and put in your Kroger Plus Card number from the back of the card. (Tip: Your account number is the phone number you signed up with.)
3. Enter the NPO number for Montwell Commons which is **HQ259** or the legal name of the organization which is the **Greenbrier Valley Restoration Project, INC**. Click confirm.
5. Confirm that the organization name shows on your information page.
6. If you have any questions, you can call 800.853.3033.

After you have linked your card, Kroger will start donating a percentage of your quarterly purchases to Montwell Commons. Note: Kroger requires that you renew your charitable designation each year.
